Minimum Requirements

Macintosh

Macintosh computer with a PowerPC G3, G4, or G5 processor
256MB of RAM (512 recommended)
DVD drive (player – for installing) and 4 Gigabytes free of hard disk drive
Video: 800x600 (1024x768 or higher preferred)
Mac OS X 10.3.9 or Mac OS X 10.4
Quicktime Installed (version 6 or higher)

Windows

Pentium III 500MHz or higher
256MB of RAM (512 recommended)
DVD drive (player – for installing) and 4 Gigabytes free of hard disk drive
Video: 800x600 (1024x768 or higher preferred)
Windows 2000 (Service Pack 4), Windows XP (Service Pack 2)
Quicktime Installed (version 6 or higher)

Installation

WARNING: Handle DVD discs with great care. Do not lay them on a hard surface or touch the underside with fingers. DVD discs are much more sensitive than CDs.

1. Insert DVD-ROM disc into a computer with a DVD player drive (does not require a DVD burner).
2. Drag and Drop (copy) the one item, “AIM GESTURE DATABASE” folder (directory), to a hard drive that has a minimum of 4 Gigabytes free.

PC USERS: Copy the folder to the root level of your C drive for easy usage (see below)

"C:\AIM GESTURE DATABASE\DATABASE_FILES"

NOTE: Purchase of this DVD entitles you to a license for installation to one computer only. Thank you. Contact AIM if you have multiple computer or server needs.

3. Eject AIM DVD and keep in a safe place (in its cover) for possible re-installation at a later date.
4. Locate the AIM GESTURE DATABASE folder – open it. You will see five items:

AIM_SUPPORT - (folder with help files inside)
DATABASE_FILES - (folder – do not touch contents)
Gestures-Mac - (an alias file for Mac Database)
Gestures-PC.exe - (a short cut file for PC Database)
PC USERS – READ ME

5. Double-click (launch) either the Gestures-Mac or Gestures-PC.exe file that matches your computer.

If Quicktime is not installed on your computer, you will be prompted to download the free player so that the clips play within the database. You can manually download/install Quicktime from:

PC USERS: If the Gestures-PC.exe does not launch the database read the “PC USERS – READ ME” file.

IMPORTANT: Do not alter, delete or change in any way, the files that reside in the DatabaseFiles Folder (directory). Additionally, do not alter the contents of the database while running it (i.e. adding entries, etc.).

The AIM Gesture Database has been priced low to meet teacher and student needs. It does not come with phone support.
